The poo & tools will be distributed to gardeners affected by the January bushfires.

The photo (look for it on the 'News' section of our website) shows Jo (L) and Kerrie (R)) from the Tasman Dunalley Neighbourhood House with the donations. This photo also shows the community fruit garden (on the left) which was badly burnt in the fires. A number of fruit trees were killed, the netting which enclosed them plus the watering system were completely destroyed plus some of the timber framing which held the net. The fence behind the garden was also lost (hence the temporary hessian fence). A few of the surviving trees have however managed to sprout new growth.
